**1. In the second paragraph of Section 3.1-Introduction, it indicates that there is interest in repairs/replacement to interior sandstone and terra cotta masonry pieces, stained glass restoration and cleaning and repainting of the interior masonry walls. It was our understanding from the second walkthrough that because this is a church, the terms of the State grant are such that the grant funds and matching funds are not eligible to be used for any interior work. Can you please clarify?**

That is correct. The City is working to obtain funds beyond the restricted grant and matching funds.

**2. It was our understanding that the City had requested clarification of whether or not structural modifications would be eligible using the grant and matchings funds (if it would involve interior work). Has clarification been received? If so, what was the determination?**

The City is still pursuing a response to this request for clarification.

**3. It was our understanding that the stained glass window restoration was to be addressed under a separate contract. Is this now part of the Architect's scope as part of RFP# R-56?**

Yes, the stained glass window restoration will be part of the scope of work.

**4. Is Section 3.3-Building Conditions just informational or are the building elements listed in 3.3 intended to be addressed with this project?**

This section is informational. The City expects that the architect will work with the City to develop a scope of work based on the outcome of the assessment in Phase I of the architect's scope.
