Has considered said matter and would recommend: Adopted for 1st Passage as Amended

Sec. 75A. Parking prohibitions towing zone (October resident parking).

A. Temporary October Resident Permit Parking. Residents of certain streets shall be granted eligibility for temporary resident permit parking, and certain streets shall be designated as temporary resident permit parking streets, from October 1 to November 1. Eligible residents will have a temporary resident parking permit sent to them in the mail and must display the permit following the written instructions included with said permit be permitted to register their vehicles through an online portal provided by the City. Residents will be required to provide proof of residence and vehicle registration such that their vehicle is identifiable to parking enforcement and police department staff based on said vehicles license plate. One temporary guest pass-permit shall be issued if requested may be purchased, in accordance with Section 75C, at a cost of \$10.00. Temporary resident permit parking signage will be installed on said streets. Temporary October Resident Permit Parking shall be in effect from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M., Monday through Friday, and 12:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. Saturday through Sunday, October 1 to November 1. Temporary October Resident Parking shall occur on the street in existing parking areas and shall not supersede other parking restrictions, including but not limited to, handicap/accessible parking spaces, parking within four (4) feet of a driveway, parking within twenty (20) feet of an intersection, or parking restricted on a certain side of the street.

Residents of the following streets shall be eligible for Temporary October Resident Permit Parking. Temporary signage shall be installed before October 1 indicating streets designated as Temporary October Resident Permit Parking streets and all parking shall be prohibited during the hours indicated except by motor vehicles residents displaying a Temporary October Resident Parking permit that are permitted to register their motor vehicles through the online portal.

B. **Permits Issued at** <u>Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation Director's Discretion.</u> The Director of the <u>Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation shall</u>, in consultation as needed with the Mayor's Office, the City Collector's Office, and the Police Traffic Unit Commander, grant other temporary parking permits as needed during the month of October as they see fit, either to residents with special circumstances or business owners on streets designated as Temporary October Resident Permit Parking Streets. - or business owners that feel they are eligible for such a permit shall contact the Director of Traffic and Parkingthe Department of Transportation at the City Hall Annex.
- C. Downtown October Resident Parking. Residents at the following addresses required to purchase parking passes at either the Museum Place Garage or South Harbor Garage shall be able to purchase a pass for \$115.00 for the month of October in the Museum Place Garage and that up to one hundred and seventy six (176) parking spaces will be sectioned off on the roof as reserved spaces for these temporary passholders no more than fifty (50) parking spaces will be sectioned off on the roof as reserved spaces for these temporary passholders. Additional spaces may be reserved at the discretion of the Director of the Department of Transportation.

Sec. 75. Parking prohibitions towing zone (resident sticker permit parking).

In order to reduce air pollution caused by fuel emissions and other environmental effects of automobile commuting, such as to reduce traffic hazards and highway congestion, noise and litter, thus encouraging reliance on carpools and mass transportation, the The City Council enacts the attached ordinance comprising the following zones for resident permit parking:

Resident Parking Zones

The following zones are hereby designated resident parking zones and only streets within these zones shall be eligible to be made limited to resident parking: ZONE A ZONE B ZONE C ZONE D ZONE E ZONE F ZONE G.

Any streets located outside ZONES A-G that are designated or should become designated for resident parking shall be part of a catch-all ZONE H.

The boundaries of the aforementioned zones are shown on a plan on file with the Director of the Department of Transportation Traffic and Parking entitled "City of Salem Residential Parking Zones: Parking Prohibitions Towing Zone (Resident Sticker) and is incorporated and made part of this ordinance.

ZONE A-BLUE

Includes Ward 1 Precinct 1 Area is adjacent to Pickering Wharf and runs to the Salem Willows Amusement Park.

ZONE B-RED

Includes area in Ward 7-encompassing Salem State College Area. This area is affected by commuter traffic attending Salem State College.

ZONE-C-GREEN

Includes area adjacent to the central downtown business district and courthouse complex in Ward 2 and parts of Zone C in Ward 3.

ZONE D-YELLOW

Includes area adjacent to the central downtown business district.

ZONE E-ORANGE

Includes area in Ward 5 encompassing Salem State College Area. This area is affected by commuter traffic attending Salem State College.

ZONE-F-WHITE

Includes areas in Ward 6.

No person shall stand or park or allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in their name to stand or park on any of the ways or parts of ways hereinafter described and during the periods of time set forth unless a resident permit has been purchased and is identifiable by parking enforcement and police department staff based on said vehicles license plate bear a clearly visible resident parking sticker_or visitor parking permit has been purchased and identifiable by parking enforcement and police department staff issued and displayed on said vehicles license plate as hereinafter provided or unless said vehicles bear a

handicapped license plate issued by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 90 Section 2.

Official Traffic Signs

The provisions of Section 75 shall be effective only during such time as sufficient number of official traffic signs bearing the legend "Tow-Away Zone" are installed, erected, maintained and located as to be visible to approaching drivers, said signs to be appended above or incorporated into the legend of Resident Parking Prohibition Signs.

Resident Parking Zones

The following zones are hereby designated resident parking zones and only streets within these zones shall be eligible to be made limited to resident parking: ZONE A ZONE B ZONE C ZONE D ZONE E ZONE F

The boundaries of the aforementioned zones are shown on a plan on file with the Director of Traffic and Parking entitled "City of Salem Residential Parking Zones: Parking Prohibitions Towing Zone (Resident Sticker) and is incorporated and made part of this ordinance.

Procedures for Designating or Modifying a Street within a Resident Parking Zone

The Transportationffic and Parking Commission shall recommend policies for designating and modifying resident sticker_parking zones. These shall include accepting petitions from residents and in coordination with the Ward Councillor, making recommendations to the City Council for approval.

Procedures for Obtaining StickersPermits.

A. Eligibility: Any motor vehicle owned by a resident domiciliary of the City of Salem registered under the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts registered and garaged in the City of Salem, excluding any vehicles prohibited from residential areas under the provisions of Chapter 42, Section 55B, shall be eligible for a Resident Parking PermitSticker provided said resident domiciliary resides in one of the zones aforementioned and streets hereinafter mentioned. A resident sticker_parking permit applicant shall provide the Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation with a vehicle registration, driver's license, and utility/household bill as proof of current residency.

In instances where an individual does not meet the above stated requirements the Police Chief or their designee, or the Director of the Department of Transportation Traffic and Parking, and upon consultation with the Ward Councillor, may alter the requirements for obtaining a resident permit in limited circumstances. Those circumstances include either an individual who resides part—time in the city, with vehicles registered elsewhere or an individual who is a non-resident property owner or landlord. In both instances no visitor parking permits shall be issued. The issued permit shall be valid for a period of one year and is only valid on designated streets within the zone the property is located within.

Eligibility of College and University Students Living Off Campus: A resident sticker_parking permit shall be issued to a College or University student living off campus with proof of a residential lease and/or utility bill in the student's name for a residence in one of the zones aforementioned and street hereinafter mentioned, College issued enrollment verification and vehicle registration, regardless of where the vehicle is registered.

Eligibility of Active-Duty Military Personnel: A resident sticker_permit shall be issued to active-duty military personnel living in Salem with proof of a residential lease and/or utility bill in the individual's name for a residence in one of the zones aforementioned and street hereinafter mentioned, verification of active-duty military status, and vehicle registration, regardless of where the vehicle is registered.

Compliance with state and local laws: No resident parking <u>permitssticker_s</u> shall be issued for any unit where the number of non-related residents violates the State Building Code and/or City Ordinances, as determined by the City's Building Inspector.

B. How and where to obtain sticker spermits: The Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation shall be in charge of issuing sticker spermits upon verification of residence, domicile and registration. The City's Police Department and Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation shall be responsible for enforcement of the ordinance. The Police Chief or their designee, or the Director of Traffic and Parkingthe Department of Transportation, may alter the requirements for obtaining a resident sticker permit in limited circumstances, and upon consultation with the Ward Councillor. Renewal of resident sticker parking permits shall be on a rolling basis by zone and staggered throughout the year, as determined by the Director of Traffic and Parkingthe Department of Transportation.

The sticker is to be placed on the front window, driver's side, lower left corner.

C. Visitor parking permits: The Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation shall also be in charge of issuing no more than two (2) portable Visitor Parking Permits per dwelling unit, as defined in Section 10 of the City's Zoning Ordinance, excluding College and University Student Resident Parking Permit holders as defined in sub-section A above, that shall be used for visitors of the residents of the area. Proof of residency is required as in Sub-Section B above. At the discretion of the Director of Traffic and Parking, visitor parking permits may either be issued in hand or mailed to a resident parking permit holder. Visitor Permits will not be replaced if lost, but still can be renewed the following year. The Visitor Permits are to be used ONLY while visitors are actually visiting the dwelling unit to which the permits are issued. Visitor permits shall carry the address of the dwelling unit to which they were issued, and shall be valid only within the immediate area of the address so stated on the permit, and for a period of time not longer than 6 7 consecutive days for any one visitor. Any abuse in the use of a Visitor Permit will result in the revocation of the Permit. The Visitor Permits are to be displayed on the front dashboard, above the steering wheel, and must be fully readable from the exterior of the vehicle. The Visitor Permits must be returned to the resident at the conclusion of the visit.

D. Fees: The fee for each Resident Parking PermitSticker_shall be \$5.00 and shall be valid for a period of one year, provided that the owner of the vehicle continues to be domiciled within the zone indicated on the resident parking permit, in the event the owner of the vehicle is domiciled outside the zone indicated, the resident parking permit shall be considered null and void. The fee for the first Visitor Parking Permit shall be \$10.00. The fee for a second Visitor Parking Permit shall be \$20.00. Each Visitor Parking Permit shall be valid for one year.

The fee for each Seasonal (enforced less than 12 months out of the year) Resident Parking Permit shall be \$5.00 and shall be valid for a period of one year, provided that the owner of the vehicle continues to be domiciled within the zone indicated on the resident parking permit, in the event the owner of the vehicle is domiciled outside the zone indicated, the resident parking permit

shall be considered null and void. The fee for the first Visitor Parking Permit shall be \$10.00. The fee for a second Visitor Parking Permit shall be \$20.00. Each Visitor Parking Permit shall be valid for one year.

The fee for each Resident Parking Permit issued to an individual who resides part -time in the city, with vehicles registered elsewhere, will be \$30.00.

The fee for each Resident Parking Permit issued to a non-resident property owner or landlord shall be \$50.00.

Fees for College and University Students Living Off Campus with non-Salem vehicle registration: The fee for each Resident Parking PermitSticker issued to a College or University student living off campus and eligible for such a Permit shall be \$10.00 and shall be valid for a period of one year, provided that the owner of the vehicle continues to be domiciled within the zone indicated on the resident parking permit. In the event the owner of the vehicle is domiciled outside the zone indicated, the resident parking permit shall be considered null and void. No Visitor Parking Permits shall be issued.

Fees for Active-Duty Military Personnel with non-Salem vehicle registration: The fee for each Resident Parking PermitSticker issued to active-duty military personnel living in Salem with non-Salem vehicle registration and eligible for such a Permit shall be waived and shall be valid for a period of one year, provided that the owner of the vehicle continues to be domiciled within the zone indicated on the resident parking permit. In the event the owner of the vehicle is domiciled outside the zone indicated, the resident parking permit shall be considered null and void.

E. Miscellaneous:

If a person loses or has their permit stolen, the Director of Traffic and Parking must be notified immediately so as to enable the Director of Traffic and Parking to notify the Police Department of Stolen or lost permits.

The Director of Traffic and Parking Department of Transportation shall keep records of the issuance of all resident stickers and permits and their expiration dates, and shall have authority to issue replacement stickers or permits at no cost in the event that they are lost or stolen, or upon proof of the sale or trade in of a vehicle which had been issued a valid Resident Parking Sticker.

32. The Director of Traffic and Parkingthe Department of Transportation is authorized to revoke the residential parking permit sticker of any person found in violation of these regulations and, upon written notification thereof, the person shall surrender the sticker and Visitor Permit (if issued) to the Director of Traffic and Parking. If the person does not return the sticker and visitor permit to the Director of Traffic and Parking as requested, the Director of Traffic and Parking shall forward the vehicle registration number and vehicle I. D. number to the Police Department.

An Ordinance relative to the licensing board

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Salem, as follows:

Section I. Sec. 2-112 – *Clerk of licensing board* of Chapter 2, Division 1 - *Generally* is hereby amended by:

- 1) Deleting the section heading "clerk of licensing board" and replacing it with "Licensing board: clerk; public notice of certain applications; authority of board.
- 2) Deleting the first two sentences of paragraph c) in their entirety and replacing them with the following:
 - "All applications for common victualer, annual or seasonal liquor, lodging house or inn, and auto dealer licenses filed with the city licensing board, for an original license issued under the General Laws of Massachusetts or under the city Code, as the case may be, or for a transfer of such a license from one location to another, or for a change in the description of a licensed premises, shall be made on a form to be prescribed by the licensing board and shall include a sworn statement by the applicant giving the names and addresses of all persons who have a direct or indirect beneficial interest in such license. Notation of the date and hour of filing shall be made on every application. Within ten days after receipt of any such application, the applicant shall cause a notice thereof to be published at the expense of the applicant."
- 3) Deleting the first two sentences of paragraph d) in their entirety and replacing them with the following:
 - "Every applicant of a license requiring public notice as set forth in section (c) for an original license, or for a transfer of such a license from one location to another, or for a change in the description of a licensed premises, or someone in the applicant's behalf, shall, within three days after publication as provided in this section, cause a copy of the published notice be sent by mail, evidenced by a certificate of mailing from the U.S. Postal Service, or in the case of liquor, lodging or inn, and auto dealer licenses by certified mail, return receipt requested, to each of the persons appearing upon the assessors' most recent valuation list as the owners of

the property abutting or within 300 feet, as the General Law provides for each license type, of the premises where the license is intended to be exercised and, if a school, which gives not less than the minimum instruction and training to children of compulsory school age required by M.G.L.A. c. 71, or a church or hospital, is located within a radius of 500 feet from the premises, to such school, church or hospital."

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by City Charter.
