## Head of School Update

- Enrollment and Recruitment: A new application was posted for next school year; 10 applicants thus far.
- Human Resources: Hired a new paraprofessional; they begin at BACS at the end of November. New teacher began in the 4th-grade science/social studies role.
- Professional Development: Two half-day professional development days in December. Both days will be focused on family engagement and preparing for PTS conferences. New initiative in grades 1 and 5: scholar-led conferences.

## Academic Update:

• Review of ANET 1 Interim Data from both ELA and Math assessments ANET 2 Interim assessment will be given the week of 12/3 for ELA and 12/10 for Math. Data action plans for A1-A2 are in effect. Teachers are excited to be using ANET again

## **Communications Committee Updates**

- ST shares that DESE wants individual unions to determine the interpretation of the current language.
- Option B is getting Innovation status.
- ST will share different autonomous school models via email.
- AD and CK share update from meeting with Superintendent and Mayor
  - Mayor and Superintendent will communicate with local union reps

#### **Charter Renewal Updates**

- Prepare a draft for January meeting

- Head of School self-assessment and goals for SY19 will be shared at next board meeting
- ST announced that she is stepping down from the board.
